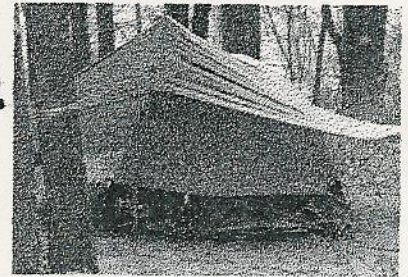

### Another Looney Patrol Recipe

*Mr. Hawley's Famous Pineapple Upside Down Cake*

1 yellow Cake Mix  
Other ingredients called out on the back of the cake mix box.  
1 can sliced pineapple  
1 jar Maraschino cherries  
¼ cup brown sugar

Line large Dutch Oven with tin foil, shiny side against oven.  
Coat foil with butter.  
Sprinkle brown sugar into bottom of Dutch Oven.  
Place pineapple slices close together in bottom of Dutch Oven.  
Place a cherry in the center of each pineapple slice.  
Prepare cake mix according to package directions.  
Pour cake batter over pineapple and cherries.  
Place lid on Dutch Oven.  
Place Dutch Oven over enough coals to cover bottom side. Place more coals on top to cover lid.  
When toothpick stuck into center of cake comes out clean, cake is done.  
Carefully lift cake out by tin foil and flip over onto plate.  
Hold back the crowd because they're going to come running once they smell the aroma!


